## Pak too plans int'l outreach on Op Sindoor

ISLAMABAD

Hours after India decided to send its delegations to key partner countries to put across its resolve to tackle terrorism against the backdrop of Operation Sindoor, Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif announced that he will send a diplomatic team to important world capitals to present the country's stance.

The decision was made by Prime Minister Shehbaz on Saturday after a telephone conversation with former foreign minister and chief of the Pakistan People's Party (PPP) Bilawal Bhutto Zardari, according to the Prime Minister's Office.

Prime Minister Shehbaz "decided to send a high-level diplomatic delegation to important world capitals to expose Indian propaganda," state-run Radio Pakistan reported.

Meanwhile, Pakistan's Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister Ishaq Dar will travel to China on Monday, where he is expected to hold bilateral talks with Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi. Afghanistan's Acting Foreign Minister Amir Khan Muttaqi will also arrive in China on May 20 to attend a trilateral meeting with Dar and Wang, Geo News reported.

### Probe into firing at high profile vehicle

Sri Lankan police on Sunday said they are investigating a shooting incident targeting the vehicle of a former aide of ex-president Ranil Wickremesinghe. Thusitha Hallololuwa, the former Director General of Public Relations to Wickremesinghe, was travelling with his lawyer and another person in Colombo's suburb of Narahenpita on Saturday night when two motorcycle-borne persons blocked its path and opened fire. They assaulted Hallololuwa and others before fleeing. The police said that an investigation has been launched. A confidential file in Hallolouwa's possession was stolen by gunmen. The police said no one was injured in the shooting incident. The vehicle suffered damage from firing.

# Israeli strikes kill 103 in Gaza

Israeli strikes across the Gaza Strip killed at least 103 people overnight and into Sunday, hospitals and medics said, and prompted the main hospital in northern Gaza to close as Israel intensifies its war in the territory that, after more than 19 months, shows no signs of abating.

More than 48 people were killed in airstrikes in and around the southern city of Khan Younis, some of which hit houses and tents sheltering displaced people, according to Nasser Hospital. Among the dead were 18 children and 13 women, hospital spokesperson Weam Fares said.

In northern Gaza, a strike on a home in the built-up Jabaliya refugee camp killed nine people from a single family, according to the Gaza health ministry's emergency services.

Another strike on a family's residence, also in Jabaliya, killed 10, including seven children and a woman, according to the civil defense, which operates under the Hamas-run government.

The Israeli military had no immediate comment on the overnight strikes. Israel blames civilian casualties from its operations on Hamas because the militant group



operates from civilian areas.

The bloodshed comes as Israel ramps up its war in Gaza with a new offensive named "Gideon's Chariots", in which Israel says it plans to seize territory, displace hundreds of thousands of Palestinians to Gaza's south and take greater control over the distribution of aid.

In northern Gaza, parts of which have been flattened by Israel's onslaught, at least 43 people were killed in multiple strikes, according to first responders from the health ministry and the civil defense. Gaza City's Shifa Hospital said among the dead, 15 were children and 12 were women.

In Jabaliya, a built-up refugee camp in northern Gaza, 10

people, including seven children and a woman were killed, according to the civil defense, which operates under the Hamas-run government. Among the dead were two parents and their three children and a father and his four children, it said.

Health officials said that fighting around the Indonesian Hospital in northern Gaza and an Israeli military "siege" prompted it to shut down.

The hospital was the main medical facility in the territory's war-wrecked north, after northern Gaza's previous main hospital, Kamal Adwan, was forced to stop serving Palestinians last year because

of Israeli strikes, as was a second facility, Beit Hanoun Hospital. The Israeli military also had no immediate comment on operations at the hospital.

In central Gaza, at least 12 people were killed in three separate strikes, hospitals said. One strike in the Zweida town killed seven people, including two children and four women, according to according to the Al-Aqsa Martyrs hospital in the town of Deir al-Balah.

The second hit an apartment in Deir al-Balah, killing two parents and their child, the hospital said. In Nuseirat camp, a strike hit a house and killed two people, said the camp's Awda hospital,

## European leaders concerned

■ A growing number of European leaders have voiced deep concern over the worsening humanitarian situation.

■ On Saturday, European Council President Antonio Costa expressed his dismay on social media, stating he was "shocked" by the developments in Gaza and demanding an end to the violence. He urged the Israeli government to lift the blockade and ensure safe, swift, and unhindered access to humanitarian aid.

■ Norway, Iceland, Ireland, Luxembourg, Malta, Slovenia, and Spain made a similar stance in a joint statement issued on Friday. "We will not be silent in front of the man-made humanitarian catastrophe that is taking place before our eyes in Gaza," the statement read.

## Russia's intense drone attacks kill 1 in Ukraine

Russia overnight into Sunday launched one of its most intense drone attacks on Ukraine since the beginning of its full-scale invasion in 2022. Russia fired a total of 273 exploding drones and decoys overnight, Ukraine's air force said. Of those, 88 were intercepted and a further 128 lost, likely having been electronically jammed. The attacks targeted the country's Kyiv, Dnipropetrovsk and Donetsk regions.

According to data from Ukraine's air force, this would be the largest drone attack Russia has launched against Ukraine since the start of the war, but Ukrainian officials have not confirmed this. The number of drones fired exceeds Russia's previous largest known single drone

attack of the war, when Russia pounded Ukraine with 267 drones on the eve of the war's third anniversary.

Kyiv regional Gov. Mykola Kalashnyk said a 28-year-old woman was killed in a drone attack on the region and three other people, including a 4-year-old child, were wounded. Meanwhile, Russia's Defence Ministry said its air defences shot down seven Ukrainian drones overnight, and a further 14 on Sunday morning.

The attacks came after the first direct talks between Moscow and Kyiv in years on Friday failed to yield a cease-fire. Russian President Vladimir Putin spurned Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy's offer to meet face-to-face in Turkey.

## Mexican navy ship strikes Brooklyn Bridge, 2 killed

A Mexican navy sailing ship on a global goodwill tour struck the Brooklyn Bridge in New York on Saturday night, snapping its three masts, fatally injuring two crew members and leaving some sailors dangling from harnesses high in the air waiting for help.

New York City Mayor Eric Adams said the 142-year-old bridge was spared major damage but at least 19 people about the ship needed medical treatment after the crash. Two of the four people who suffered more serious injuries later died, Adams announced on social media early Sunday morning.

The cause of the collision was under investigation. In a scene captured in multiple eyewitness videos, the ship, called the Cuauhtemoc, could be seen travelling swiftly



toward the bridge near the Brooklyn side of the East River. Then, its three masts struck the bridge's main span and snapped, one by one, as the ship kept moving.

Videos showed heavy traffic on the span at the time of the 8:20 pm collision. The vessel, which was flying a giant green, white and red Mexican flag and had 277 people aboard, then drifted toward the piers lining the riverbank as onlookers

scrambled away.

Sailors could be seen aloft in the rigging on the damaged masts but, remarkably, no one fell into the water, officials said.

Sydney Neidell and Lily Katz told The Associated Press they were sitting outside to watch the sunset when they saw the vessel strike the bridge. Looking closer, they saw someone dangling from high on the ship.

## Romanian prez poll pits nationalist against centrist

Romanians were voting on Sunday in a tense presidential runoff between a hard-right nationalist and a pro-Western centrist in a high-stakes election rerun that could determine the geopolitical direction of the European Union and NATO member country.

The race pits front-runner George Simion, the 38-year-old leader of the hard-right Alliance for the Unity of Romanians, or AUR, against incumbent Bucharest Mayor Nicusor Dan. It comes months after the cancellation



of the previous election plunged Romania into its worst political crisis in decades.

**Poles vote for new prez**

Poles are voting Sunday in a presidential election at a time of heightened security concerns stemming from the ongoing war in neighbouring Ukraine and growing worry that the US commitment to Europe's security could be weakening under President Donald Trump.

The top two front-runners are Warsaw Mayor Rafal Trzaskowski, a liberal allied with Prime Minister Donald Tusk, and Karol Nawrocki, a conservative historian with no prior political experience who is supported by the national conservative Law and Justice party.

## Portugal holds third poll in 3 yrs

**Lisbon:** Voters in Portugal returned to the polls Sunday for a third general election in three years. Hopes that the ballot might end the worst spell of political instability in decades for the European Union country of 10.6 million people could be dashed, however. Polls suggest the election is poised to deliver yet another minority government. "What the polls indicate is that there will not be major differences from the last election results," says Marina Costa Lobo, head researcher at Lisbon University's Institute of Social Sciences. —**Agencies**

## Pope Leo XIV vows to work for unity

VATICAN CITY

Pope Leo XIV, history's first American pope, vowed Sunday to work for unity so that the Catholic Church becomes a symbol of peace in the world, offering a message of communion during an inaugural Mass in St. Peter's Square before an estimated 200,000 pilgrims, presidents, patriarchs and princes.

Leo officially opened his pontificate by taking his first popemobile tour through the piazza, a rite of passage that has become synonymous with the papacy's global reach and mediatic draw. The 69-year-old Augustinian missionary smiled and waved from the back of the truck, and stopped to bless some babies in the crowd.

During the Mass, Leo appeared to choke up when the two potent symbols of the papacy were placed on him - the lambswool stole over his shoulders and the fisherman's ring on his finger - as if the weight of responsibility of leading the 1.4-billion strong church had just sunk in.

He turned his hand to look at the ring and seal and then clasped his hands in front of him in prayer.

US Vice-President J.D. Vance and Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky met for the first time since a notable White House dispute, shaking hands and sharing smiles at the Vatican on Sunday. Their encounter took place amidst celebrations for the enthronement of the newly chosen pontiff, Pope Leo XIV.

died, led the US delegation honouring the Chicago-born Leo. Vance paid his respects at the Argentine pope's tomb upon arriving in Rome late Saturday.

In his homily, Leo said he wanted to be a servant to the faithful through the two dimensions of the papacy, love and unity, so that the church could be a force for peace in the world.

"I would like that our first great desire be for a united church, a sign of unity and communion, which becomes a haven for a reconciled world," he said. His call for unity was significant, given the polarisation in the Catholic Church in the United States and beyond.

## 1 killed in US explosion

**Palm Springs:** An explosion killed a person and heavily damaged a fertility clinic Saturday in the upscale California city of Palm Springs in what the FBI characterised as an "intentional act of terrorism." Akiel Davis, the head of the FBI's Los Angeles field office, said in the evening that the clinic was deliberately targeted, while declining to elaborate on how authorities have

reached a conclusion on a motive. Authorities were still working to confirm the identity of the person who died at the scene. Davis would not directly say whether that person was the suspect but said authorities were not searching for a suspect. Davis also said four people were hurt but provided no additional details on the severity of the injuries.



Pursuant to the global landscape for European funds and European macroeconomic factors being sluggish and in the interest of unitholders, Franklin India Feeder- Templeton European Opportunities Fund (FIF-TEOF) shall be merged with Franklin India Feeder - Franklin U.S. Opportunities Fund (FIF-FUSOF) as on June 30, 2025. Consequently, from the date of merger i.e., effective June 30, 2025, the investors of merging scheme would become investors of surviving scheme.

The sale of the units of FIF-TEOF (including switch-in) will stand suspended w.e.f. May 29, 2025 except in respect of Systematic Investment Plan (SIP), Systematic Transfer Plan (STP) and Transfer of Income Distribution Cum Withdrawal Plan (TIDCW). Registration of SIP / STP / TIDCW will also be suspended w.e.f. from May 29, 2025.

The requirement of minimum application amount for fresh and additional purchase of units as mentioned in the Scheme Information Document will not be applicable in respect of the units of Surviving Scheme allotted to the investors of Merging Scheme(s) on account of the merger.

Further, the portfolio of Merging Scheme(s) as on the date of merger, which is valued as per SEBI Guidelines, will be merged with the portfolio of Surviving Scheme.

In case of investors in Merging Scheme(s) who opt to continue in Surviving Scheme post-merger and have registered for any of the systematic transaction facility viz., SIP, STP, TIDCW or Systematic Withdrawal Plan (SWP) in Merging Scheme(s), the said registration for SIP, STP, TIDCW or SWP will continue under Surviving Scheme(s) for its balance tenure subsequent to the merger.

If the investors do not wish to continue the systematic transactions under Surviving Scheme, the investors are required to intimate Franklin Templeton Mutual Fund in writing their unwillingness to continue the said facilities latest by 3p.m on June 27, 2025.

In respect of the units in Merging Scheme(s) which are under any pledge / lien / encumbrance, such pledge/lien/encumbrance will continue on the units allotted in Surviving Scheme(s) on account of merger.

Subsequent to the merger, the Merging Scheme viz. FIF-TEOF shall cease to exist.

Unitholders who do not exercise the exit option on or before June 27, 2025 would be deemed to have consented to the proposed change.

Unitholders who have pledged their units will need to procure a release of their pledge prior to submitting their redemption request.

The Merger has been approved by the Board of Directors of the Franklin Templeton Asset Management (India) Pvt. Ltd. (investment manager for schemes of Franklin Templeton Mutual Fund) and Franklin Templeton Trustee Services Pvt. Ltd. (the Trustee to the schemes of Franklin Templeton Mutual Fund).

It may be noted that pursuant to the merger, there will be no fundamental attribute change in the scheme features of FIF-FUSOF.

**Change in name of Franklin India Feeder - Franklin U.S. Opportunities Fund (FIF- FUSOF)**

Further, pursuant to Para 2.6.5 of SEBI Master Circular dated June 27, 2024 and SEBI Letter to AMFI dated February 6, 2025, the scheme name of FIF-FUSOF is being changed to Franklin U.S. Opportunities Equity Active Fund of Funds with effect from May 30, 2025.

All the other terms and conditions of the Scheme Information Document and Key Information Memorandum of the Scheme, read with the addenda issued from time to time, will remain unchanged.
